MR. JACOBSON

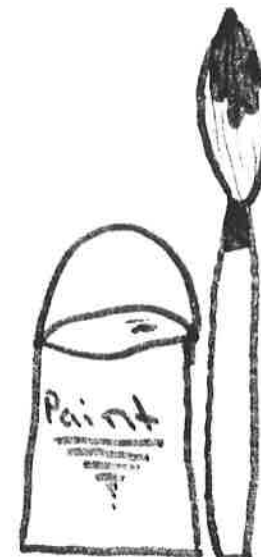
