5th Grade Global Virtual Classroom (GVC) Project

The Global Virtual Classroom Contest is a global team cooperation and website-building activity. Using Internet technologies to communicate, teams of schools from around the world work together to build a website.

The Global Virtual Classroom (GVC) Project emphasizes collaboration and telecommunication throughout the world. Students learn effective communication with all ages and cultures. Students celebrate their varied talents and combine those talents to create a product greater than any one individual could create alone. They learn how to learn, and are taught new software products and educational themes.

After working together for the last 6 months, approximately 1,800 students from 73 schools, representing 26 countries around the world unveiled 24 websites as part of the Global Virtual Classroom Contest 2014. The Global Virtual Classroom contest is sponsored by AT&T International as well as GBSI- Give Something Back International.

The 5th grade team from Lincoln School teamed up with a school from the Czech Republic to create the website: The Universe of Food. For this website students created their own cooking shows, recipes, and their own Garageband music. Students also created original Scratch games that encourage others to eat healthy.

We would like to thank Mr. P (Ljubomir Perkovic) for all of his time and efforts in teaching the fifth graders how to use Scratch. Mr. P would come in weekly to work with the students on their Scratch games. He is the father of fifth grader Ellie Sigel.

For all of their hard work, our team was recognized with a special merit award for exceptional multimedia. This is the tenth GVC award that the students at Lincoln have won over the past twelve years.
